

1 A bill to be entitled
 2 An act relating to menstrual hygiene products in
 3 public schools; creating s. 1006.064, F.S.; defining
 4 the term "menstrual hygiene products"; authorizing
 5 school districts to make menstrual hygiene products
 6 available, at no charge, in schools within the
 7 district and at certain locations within such schools;
 8 requiring participating schools to notify students of
 9 the availability and locations of such products;
 10 encouraging school districts to partner with specified
 11 organizations to supply and maintain such menstrual
 12 hygiene products; providing an effective date.

 14 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 16 Section 1. Section 1006.064, Florida Statutes, is created
 17 to read:

18 1006.064 Availability of menstrual hygiene products.—

19 (1) As used in this section, the term "menstrual hygiene
 20 products" means tampons and sanitary napkins for use in
 21 connection with the menstrual cycle.

22 (2) A school district may make menstrual hygiene products
 23 available in each school within the district, at no charge. The
 24 menstrual hygiene products may be located in the school nurse's
 25 office, other school facilities for health services, and in

26 | restrooms within each school, including wheelchair accessible
27 | restrooms.

28 | (3) Participating schools shall ensure that students are
29 | provided appropriate notice as to the availability and location
30 | of the menstrual hygiene products.

31 | (4) School districts are encouraged to partner with
32 | nonprofit organizations, nongovernmental organizations,
33 | businesses, and other organizations to assist in supplying and
34 | maintaining such menstrual hygiene products.

35 | Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
