7 uniform crash reports by electronic means to the department
8 using a nonproprietary, interchangeable electronic form and
9 reporting method. For purposes of this section, nonproprietary
10 means commonly used and commercially available report formats
11 and reporting methods. Such crash reports must be consistent
12 with the state traffic crash manual rules and the procedures
13 established by the department and must be appropriately numbered
14 and inventoried. A Florida Traffic Crash Report, Long Form must
15 be completed and electronically submitted to the department
16 within 10 days after an investigation is completed by the law

33 agencies and their contracted service providers, victim services
34 programs, and any federal, state, or local governmental agency
35 or any private person or entity acting on behalf of a federal,
36 state, or local governmental agency in carrying out its
37 functions, but not for redistribution to any person or entity

42 parties involved in the crash shall be made immediately
43 available to radio and television stations licensed by the
44 Federal Communications Commission and newspapers qualified to
45 publish legal notices under ss. 50.011 and 50.031. A crash
46 report may also be made available to any third party acting on
47 behalf of a person or entity authorized under this section to
48 access the crash report, except that the third party may
49 disclose the crash report only to the person or entity
50 authorized to access the crash report under this section on
51 whose behalf the third party has sought the report. This section
52 shall not prevent an agency, pursuant to a memorandum of
53 understanding, from providing data derived from crash reports to
54 a third party solely for the purpose of identifying vehicles
55 involved in crashes if such data does not reveal the identity,
56 home or employment telephone number or home or employment
57 address, or other personal information of the parties involved
58 in the crash.
