Survivors Urge Lawmakers to Protect Access to Courts and Justice

Individuals impacted by catastrophic negligence will speak about the devastating impact HB 837/SB 236 will have and urge lawmakers to reconsider fast-tracking the legislation.

Tallahassee, FL -- Survivors of negligence and catastrophic injuries from across the state will gather at the Capitol to urge Florida lawmakers to vote against **House Bill 837/Senate Bill 236** on Wednesday, March 8th on the 4th Floor of the Florida Capitol Building at 10:30 am ET.

Survivors will share their stories on how the current bills being fast-tracked in the Legislature, **House Bill 837/Senate Bill 236**, would strip Floridians of their access to the courts and limit their ability to seek damages for injuries caused by the negligence of others.
