## **ICYMI: Leon County Delegation Met Ahead of the 2024 Legislative Session**

**TALLAHASSEE, Fla.** - Last night, Thursday, October 5<sup>th</sup> at 5pm, the Leon County Delegation met in the Tallahassee City Commission Chambers to give the people of Leon County a chance to talk to their elected leaders about issues that they wanted them to be aware of for the upcoming 2024 Legislative Session.

The delegation led by its Chair, **Representative Allison Tant (D-District 9)** alongside **Representative Jason Shoaf (R-District 7)**; **Representative Gallop Franklin II (D-District 8)**; and **Senator Corey Simon (R-District 3)** listened to their constituents about all of their thoughts and hopes for the 2024 Legislative Session.

Topics brought before the delegation included Florida's changing environment, problems seen by educators in their schools, and the power that home rule should have versus the state government among many others. Many speakers, both at the local government level and those who serve as advocates, spoke about coming to visit their different leaders at the Legislature in order to continue the conversations that started last night.

After listening to more than 60 people and lasting for just more than four hours, each member of the delegation thanked everyone who spoke and listened during tonight's meeting.
