House Bill 207 (Senate Bill number to be announced soon) would among many things set Florida's Weekly Benefit Amount (WBA) to be at a maximum of \$500 and a minimum of \$100, increase the amount of weeks available to 26 weeks, establish a three week timeline for the Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) to provide an eligibility determination, create an Alternative Base Period (ABP) to allow for greater eligibility and implement an ombudsman to provide an oversight arm over DEO.
