**Representative Anika T. Omphroy Statement on Budget Signing**

**Lauderdale Lakes, FL** – This week, Governor DeSantis received and signed the record-breaking \$109.9 billion state budget for the 2022 Fiscal Year. **Representative Anika T. Omphroy (D-Lauderdale Lakes)** secured \$3,319,595 in funding for House District 95 while assuming the responsibility of representing adjoining districts that did not have elected advocates. Appropriations expanding Alzheimer’s services for seniors, gun violence reduction, fire rescue training and various water infrastructure projects were included in the state budget for cities throughout central Broward County.

After the signing of the budget, **Representative Omphroy** issued the following statement:

“District 95 is the most democratic district in the entire state of Florida. Working across the aisle and with my democratic colleagues is the only way to accomplish the goals of my district. I’m thankful for all my cities’ local elected officials who traveled to Tallahassee to help advocate for our priority projects. Thank you to Chair Trumbull, Speaker Sprowls and Governor DeSantis for hearing our requests and understanding the needs of our community.”
