# Legislative Fellows Program

The Legislative Fellows Program provides college graduates pursuing a graduate degree with an opportunity to experience the legislative process and public policy making.

### Rate of Pay/Hours of Work

The rate of pay is \$15.00 per hour. From October 11 through December 31, 2024, participants work 20 hours per week. From January 2 through May 16, 2025, participants work 30 hours per week.

#### Tuition or Stipend Benefit

Participants receive payment of up to 18 hours of graduate tuition at Florida in-state rates during the time of the fellowship or receive a monthly stipend of \$500 from October 11 through December 31, 2024, and \$800 from January 2 through May 16, 2025.

#### Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be a Florida resident or be enrolled in a Florida school at the time of application. Applicants must have received their bachelor's degree and be enrolled in a graduate program prior to beginning the Legislative Fellows Program. Law school students must be a 2L or 3L to be considered for the program.
