IV. ECONOMIC IMPACT:

Potential Advantages:

Include all possible outcomes linked to the bill, such as increased efficiencies, and positive or negative changes to tax revenue. - 1. Advantages to Individuals: On a county-wide basis, taxpayers would pay a more equitable share of the cost of mosquito control services and benefit from a reduce millage rate. LCMCD is providing overlapping coverage of FMB out of ad valorem taxes collected from Lee County taxpayers.
- 2. Advantages to Businesses: <u>The same advantages to individuals would be applied to businesses county-wide in this case.</u>
- 3. Advantages to Government: <u>This would provide single source services and streamline operations. Commissioner and administrative positions would be eliminated and duties would be absorbed by existing personnel at LCMCD. Only two positions at FMB would be moved to LCMCD.</u>

Potential Disadvantages:

- 1. Disadvantages to Individuals: Residents of FMB would pay additional ad valorem taxes under this plan however, this would offset what the Lee County taxpayers have been subsidizing over the years when providing services to overlapping areas of FMB (see narrative below).
- 2. Disadvantages to Businesses: <u>The same disadvantages to individuals would be applied to FMB businesses in this case.</u>
- 3. Disadvantages to Government: <u>There are no disadvantages to government; mosquito operations would be absorbed with current existing capacity.</u>

V. DESCRIBE THE POTENTIAL IMPACT OF THE BILL ON PRESENT GOVERNMENTAL SERVICES:

A combination of the two districts will streamline governmental services offered to the public and further eliminate confusion over which district to call for services. The operational plan to merge the districts will save costs on maintaining one set of commissioners, administrative office staff, and field personnel. LCMCD currently has capacity to cover the entire area of FMB. The expense of re-building FMB facilities and purchasing new equipment would be eliminated.
