The bill would allow the Broward County Senior Services District to levy up to 0.5 mills on the assessed valuation of all properties in the county which are subject to ad valorem county taxes if the district is approved by a majority vote of the electorate on November 3, 2020. The estimated revenue is based on the July 1st 2019 certified county-wide property tax roll used for the FY20 budget and assumes the district would levy the maximum amount allowable under the bill. The cost estimates are 95% of the estimated revenues assuming that the district spends everything each year. Both the revenue and cost estimates are estimates based on the maximum amount allowable; actual revenues and expenditures could change based on the future value of the property tax roll.
