NOTICE OF INTENT TO SEEK SPECIAL ACT LEGISLATION

The Board of District Trustees of the Ponte Vedra Beach Municipal Service District of St. Johns County, Florida (PVBMSD), gives notice in accordance with Article III, Section 10, and Article VII, Section 9 of the Florida Constitution, that it has requested the Legislative Delegation of St. Johns County, Florida to introduce before the Legislature of the State of Florida a special act, the substance of which is as follows: The proposed special act would amend Chapter 2002-373 Laws of Florida to (1) establish an overall limit of 12 years that an individual may serve as an elected Trustee of the PVBMSD; (2) modifying the spending limit for the PVBMSD on any individual capital project that may be pursued without approval of PVBMSD voters from \$150,000, to \$150,000 or 25% of the PVBMSD's annual budget, whichever is greater; and 3) modifying the limit on contingency reserves that may be held by the PVBMSD in any fiscal year from \$200,000, to \$200,000 or 25% of the PVBMSD's annual budget, whichever is greater.
