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NOTICE OF HEARING AND NOTICE OF INTENT TO SEEK LEGISLATION

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is hereby given of intent to apply to the 2020 Florida Legislature for passage of an act relating to The School Board of Monroe County, Florida.

The Bill is being proposed to eliminate existing construction financing limita-tions regarding capital expenditure sources for student stations and pro-vide for The Monroe County School Board to be exempt from any cost per student station restrictions including 1013.64 Florida Statutes. The Bill text is provided below.

A bill to be entitled
An act relating to Monroe County
School Board, Monroe County; providing legislative findings and intent;
providing an exception to general law;
exempting Monroe County School
Board from certain capital funds cost
per student station limitations; authorizing the school hoard to use specified rizing the school board to use specified funds for capital needs; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The Legislature finds that general law provides for a limitation on the sources of capital funds for school construction and cost per student sta-tions under s. 1013.64, Florida Stat-utes. The Legislature further finds that Monroe County Schools must be built to category five hurricane standards in order to provide safe refuges of last resort and shelters due to hurricanes. Further, the cost of construction in Mon-roe County is much greater than other comparable school districts. Therefore, comparable school districts. Therefore, it is the intent of the Legislature to exempt Monroe County School Board from such limitations.

Section 2. Notwithstanding s. 1013.64. Florida Statutes, the Monroe County School Board shall be:

(1) Exempt from the financing restrictions and the cost per stu-

dent station limitations provided in s. 1013.64(6)(b). Florida Statutes.

(2) Authorized to use for capital needs the funds from the following sources: Public Education Capital Outlay and Debt Service Trust Fund: School District and Community College District Capital Outlay and Debt Service Trust Fund: Classrooms First Program funds provided in s. 1013.68. Florida Statutes: nonvoted 1.5-mill levy of ad valorem property taxes provided in s. 1011.71(2). Florida Statutes: Classroom for Kids Program funds provided in s. 1013.735. Florida Statutes: the District Effort Recognition Program funds pro-1013.735. Florida Statutes; the District Effort Recognition Program funds provided in s. 1013.736. Florida Statutes; or High Growth District Capital Outlay Assistance Grant Program funds provided in s. 1013.738. Florida Statutes.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
