9s For Warriors has partnered with Purdue University and HABRI Foundation (Human Animal Bond Research Initiative) to conduct studies which scientifically evaluate the therapeutic efficacy of K9s For Warriors' Service Dogs on the mental health and wellness of military veterans suffering from PTSD. Please see attached studies published in Psychoneuroendocrinology, Journal of Consulting and Clinical Psychology, and Frontiers in Veterinary Science. Additional studies are forthcoming.

These funds will help us acquire, screen, and train dogs to become Service Dogs for twenty (25) Florida-based veterans and cover all costs associated with the three-week, in-house training for the veterans. For 2019, it cost approximately \$24,490.82 for each warrior/Service Dog team to graduate from our program. Our warriors pay nothing out of pocket when they come through our program.
