In 2020-2021, there were 2,289 reports of alleged exploitation to the Florida Abuse Hotline (Florida Dept. of Children and Families 2020-2021 Annual Human Trafficking Report). To increase awareness and education to individuals with native languages other than English, the Florida Alliance is seeking to expand its existing training course and offer it in a variety of languages.
