34 (3)1- Each such member's term of office shall be for 4

38 appointee of the City of Plant City and the first term of one of
39 the appointees of Hillsborough County shall be for 2 years.

40 (4)2- Vacancies occurring in the governing body for any
41 such members prior to the expiration of the affected term shall
42 be filled for the unexpired term in the same manner as the
43 original appointment.

44 (5)3- The Governor shall have the authority to remove from
45 office any such member of the governing body in the manner and
46 for cause defined by the laws of this state.

12 applicant or licensee must have provided a detailed explanation,
13 with supporting documentation, as to the basis for each of the
14 claims for which the applicant or licensee proposed to charge-
15 back the dealer and a written statement containing the basis
16 upon which the motor vehicle dealer was selected for audit or
17 review. Thereafter the applicant or licensee must have provided
18 the motor vehicle dealer's representative a reasonable period
19 after the meeting within which to respond to the proposed
20 charge-backs, said period to be commensurate with the volume of
21 claims under consideration, but in no case less than 45 days

23 prohibited from changing or altering the basis for each of the
24 proposed charge-backs as presented to the motor vehicle dealer's

27 basis for one or more charge-backs. If the applicant or
28 licensee has claimed the existence of new information, the
29 dealer must have been given the same right to a meeting and
30 right to respond as when the charge-back was originally
31 presented.
