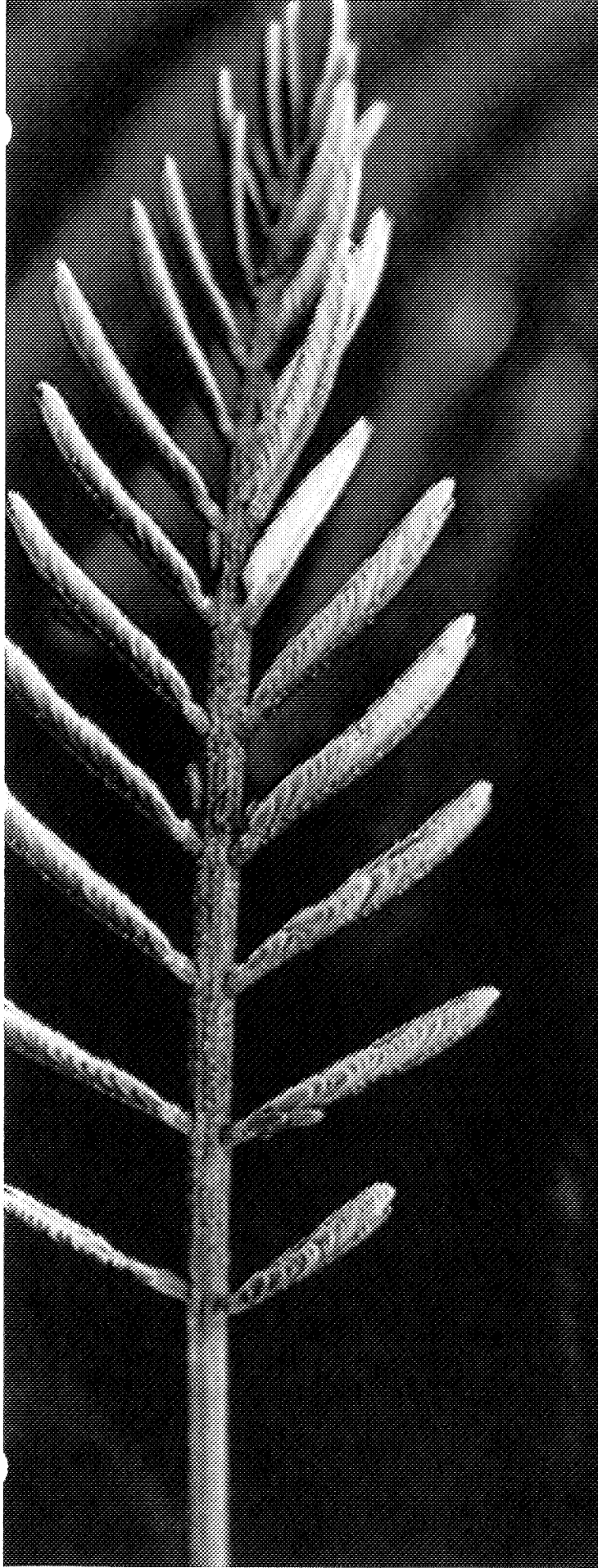

Executive Order 07-126 Implementation

December 2007

Executive Order 07-126 - Background

Governor Crist's Executive Order 07-126 commits Florida to becoming a leader in reducing greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions.

Governor's Justification for EO 07-126

- Florida's state government is largest employer in Florida, spends more than \$1 billion in annual commodity purchases, and has 16.8 million square feet of office space statewide
- Florida state government must lead by example in the fight against global climate change by reducing GHG emissions and demonstrating the economic value of such reductions (e.g., returns to taxpayers through reduced energy costs)
- Targets:
 - **10% reduction** of current emissions by **2012**
 - **40% reduction** of current emissions by **2025**
- Initial assessment (baseline carbon footprint) completed and being reviewed by EOG

Executive Order 07-126 - Agency Action Plans

- Development of templates for agencies to capture GHG emissions for consistent reporting
- Development of templates used to capture opportunities for facility and vehicle emission reductions
- Portal that provides link to existing information for all end users – Serve to Preserve
- Deployment of energy conservation guidelines for facility managers and employees
- Creation of the preferred products list on MyFlorida Marketplace website

Executive Order 07-126 – Next Steps

Over the next 30 days the following activities will be under way to reduce GHG emissions / energy consumption in state agencies:

- The release of the first-ever Florida Government Carbon Footprint report by EOG, which will serve as the baseline for future reductions
- First meeting of Agency Energy and Climate Change Coordinators to review the report and the next steps in planning to reduce agencies' GHG emissions and energy consumption
- DMS & DEP will officially rollout enhanced Serve to Preserve website –www.myfloridacclimate.com, which provides more information related to climate change activities
- DMS will continue evaluating its owned portfolio for opportunities to attain Energy Star and/or LEED certification, and will align its capital expenditures and planning activities with LEED and Energy Star criteria
