Amendment to Amendment (1) by Representative Grant (with title amendment)

Between line(s) 30-31, insert:

Section 4. Paragraph (c) of subsection (3) and subsection

(8) of section 190.006, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

190.006. Board of Supervisors; members and meetings. --

(3)(c) Candidates seeking election to office by qualified electors under this subsection shall conduct their campaigns in accordance with the provisions of chapter 106 and shall file qualifying papers and qualify for individual seats in accordance with s. 99.061. Candidates shall pay a qualifying fee, which shall consist of a filing fee and an election assessment or, as an alternative, shall file a petition signed by not less than 1 percent of the registered voters of the district, and take the oath required in s. 99.021, with the supervisor of elections in the county affected by such candidacy. The amount of the filing fee is 3 percent of \$7,5004,800; however, if the electors have provided for compensation pursuant to subsection (8), the amount of the filing fee is 3 percent of the maximum annual

compensation so provided. The amount of the election assessment is 1 percent of \$7,5004,800; however, if the electors have provided for compensation pursuant to subsection (8), the amount of the election assessment is 1 percent of the maximum annual compensation so provided. The filing fee and election assessment shall be distributed as provided in s. 105.031(3).

(8) Each supervisor shall be entitled to receive for his or her services an amount not to exceed \$200 per meeting of the board of supervisors, not to exceed \$7500 4,800 per year per supervisor, or an amount established by the electors at referendum. In addition, each supervisor shall receive travel and per diem expenses as set forth in s. 112.061.

Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.

Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert: Section 1. Section 116.07, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

116.07 Account books to be kept by sheriffs and clerks.—All sheriffs and clerks of the circuit court and ex officio clerks of the boards of county commissioners of this state shall prepare financial statements and keep books of account and of record in accordance with part III of chapter 218 s. 218.33.

Section 2. 116.075 The Clerk of the Circuit Court, as county auditor, shall prepare the annual report of the county as required by s. 218.32, F.S., and may perform such audits and tests as necessary to determine the adequacy of internal controls and compliance with contracts, applicable laws, and rules.

Section 3. Section 136.05, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

prohibited.—The clerk of the circuit court, as accountant of the board of county commissioners, shall keep an accurate and complete set of books showing the amount on hand, amount received, amount expended, and the balances thereof at the end of each month for each and every fund carried by the said board.
