# The Constitutional Amendment Limits Class Sizes

November 2002 establishing, by the beginning of the 2010-2011 school year, the maximum number of students in core-curricula courses assigned to a teacher in each of the following three grade groups:

- ❖18 students in Prekindergarten through Grade 3.
- ❖22 students in Grades 4 through 8
- ❖25 students in Grades 9 through 12

# Section 1003.03(2), Florida Statutes, <u>Implements the Constitutional Amendment by</u> <u>Establishing measures for Compliance.</u>

- Establishes a baseline based on data from the February 2003 student membership survey.
- Establishes a method of measuring compliance and schedule for implementation.
- Establishes requirements of those districts found to be non-compliant.






# Percent of Schools Over Class Size Cap

#### **Traditional Schools**




# Percent of Schools Over Class Size Cap

#### **Charter Schools**




## Percent of Classrooms Over Class Size Cap




# Percent of Classrooms Over Class Size Cap

## 2007-08 Process and Timelines for Appeals

**November 30** – Districts and Charter Schools receive October 2007 school-level class size averages and appeals process begins.

January 2 - Deadline for submission of appeal and supporting documentation.

January 2 - January 14 - Review of appeals.

February 4 – State Board of Education approval of transfer calculation.

**February 15** – Submission to the Legislative Budget Commission for final approval of transfer calculation.

# School-Level Compliance 2007-2008 Post- Appeals

- 23 Traditional (0.75%) and 8 Charter (2.27%) Schools were determined to not have met compliance with class size requirements.
- 16 districts had at least 1 school out of compliance



- Commissioner, under new statutory authority, recommended the reduction of the transfer amount by 10% for 2007-08.
- Action taken by State Board of Education on February 4, 2008
  - Approved alternative transfer calculation for noncompliance with class size reduction requirements
  - Determination of ineligibility of noncompliant schools from participation in the 2008-09 School-Year Voluntary Prekindergarten Program
- Action by the Legislative Budget Commission

1. Tables 1., 2. and 3. and Chart 1-- Population Changes for Approximately Every 20 Days in 2006-07

Four views are provided to show the changes across the 2006-07 School Year. The first table shows raw totals of pupil populations across each of the specific dates while the second shows the percentage change from the prior month. The final column in the second table shows the change from the count of September 15, 2006. The third table provides the net percentage change from the first count date (9/15/06) to the last count date sorted by percentage change.

Notable in these tables are the changes that show that 10 districts gained population from the first count (9/15/06) to the last count while 57 districts lost population over that span of time.

Chart 1 provides a graphic presentation of the changes referenced in Table 3.

2. Charts 2-5 -- Net Change in Selected Grade Membership

Charts 2-5 provide a graphic representation of the change in membership counts across the 9 count dates for each of the grades 3, 6, 9, and 12. Notable points are the changes from the first to the last point in grades 9 and 12.
