35 maintain a roster of facilities in the ADRC's district
36 boundaries that are licensed under this part and a list of
37 available residential placement openings in those facilities.
38 The licensed facilities under this part shall report to their
39 respective ADRC residential placement openings and facility
40 restrictions on those placements. Upon request, the Aged and
41 Disabled Resource Centers shall relay to the public information
42 about the availability of residential placement openings and
43 facility restrictions on the placements.
