Description:

Prevention Services: Active Number of Children and Documented Family Support Services by Lead Agency as of June 30, 2013 Florida Safe Families Network (FSFN) Data Repository as of 7/10/2013

Note: Lead Agency is based on the county of the primary caseworker assigned. The counts of children with a Family Suppport Service Ever Documented is an unduplicated count in each row. If a child received multiple family support services within a single lead agency, they are only counted once within that lead agency. If a child received family support services in multiple lead agencies, they are counted once in each lead agency in which they received a service. The other columns are counts of services and children are counted once for each service received.

In-Home Services, Out-of-Home Care and Independent Living: Number of Children and Young Adults Active by Primary Worker - Statewide by District by Agency as of June 30, 2013

Young Adult Services - The number of young adult services represents the number of young adults with a worker assigned on that date.

Other Settings - Includes Adoption Placement, Runaway/Absconded/Abducted, Subsidized Independent Living, and Other Settings

Maintenance Adoption Subsidy: Maintenance Adoption Subsidy (MAS) counts come from an ad hoc report from the Florida Safe Families Network (FSFN) Financial Module. The numbers are as of June 30, last day of the fiscal year.
