(c) This subsection is subject to the Open Government
Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand
repealed on October 2, 2019, unless reviewed and saved from
repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.

Section 2. (1) The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity that information about the location of safe houses and safe foster homes held by an agency, as defined in s. 119.011, Florida Statutes, be made confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a), Article I of the State Constitution. Safe houses and safe foster homes are intended as refuges for sexually exploited victims from those who exploited them. If the individuals who victimized these people were able to learn the location of such safe houses, they may attempt to contact their victims, exploit their vulnerabilities, and return them to the situations in which they were victimized. Even without the return of these victims to their former situations, additional contact with those who victimized them would have the effect of continuing their victimization and inhibit their recoveries. Additionally, knowledge about the location of safe houses and safe foster homes could enable other individuals to locate and attempt to victimize the residents. Therefore, it is the finding of the Legislature that such information must be made confidential and exempt from public disclosure.

Section 3. This act shall take effect on the same date that HB 1017 or similar legislation relating to human trafficking takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes a law.
