Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 1009.286, Florida Statutes, is amended, and paragraph (i) is added to subsection (4) of that section, to read:

1009.286 Additional student payment for hours exceeding baccalaureate degree program completion requirements at state universities.-

(2) State universities shall require a student to pay an excess hour surcharge for each credit hour in excess of the number of credit hours required to complete the baccalaureate degree program in which the student is enrolled. The excess hour surcharge does not apply to a first-time-in-college student who completes the requirements for the student's respective baccalaureate degree program within 4 years. The excess hour surcharge shall become effective for students who enter a state

27 university for the first time and maintain continuous enrollment
28 as follows:

29 (a) For the 2009-2010 and 2010-2011 academic years, an
30 excess hour surcharge equal to 50 percent of the tuition rate
31 for each credit hour in excess of 120 percent.

32 (b) For the 2011-2012 academic year, an excess hour
33 surcharge equal to 100 percent of the tuition rate for each
34 credit hour in excess of 115 percent.

35 (c) For the 2012-2013 academic year and thereafter, an
36 excess hour surcharge equal to 100 percent of the tuition rate
37 for each credit hour in excess of 110 percent.

38 (4) For purposes of this section, credit hours earned
39 under the following circumstances are not calculated as hours
40 required to earn a baccalaureate degree:

41 (i) Credit hours earned in upper-division-level courses
42 that must be repeated to meet the requirements for a
43 baccalaureate degree in a science, technology, engineering, or
44 mathematics discipline.

45 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
