1012.315 Screening standards.-A person is ineligible for educator certification or employment in any position that requires direct contact with students in a district school system, a charter school, or a private school that participates in a state scholarship program under chapter 1002 if the person is on the disqualification list maintained by the department pursuant to s. 1001.10(4)(b), is registered as a sex offender as described in 42 U.S.C. s. 9858f(c)(1)(C), would be ineligible PCS for CSHB 1505 a2

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for an exemption under s. 435.07 (4)(c), or has been convicted or found guilty of, has had adjudication withheld for, or has pled guilty or nolo contendere to:
