7 Section 10. Effective January 1, 2023, subsection (5) is
8 added to section 1012.315, Florida Statutes, to read:

9 1012.315 Screening standards.—A person is ineligible for
10 educator certification or employment in any position that
11 requires direct contact with students in a district school
12 system, a charter school, or a private school that participates
13 in a state scholarship program under chapter 1002 if the person
14 is on the disqualification list maintained by the department
15 pursuant to s. 1001.10(4)(b), is registered as a sex offender as
16 described in 42 U.S.C. s. 9858f(c)(1)(C), would be ineligible

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17 for an exemption under s. 435.07(4)(c), or has been convicted or
18 found guilty of, has had adjudication withheld for, or has pled
19 guilty or nolo contendere to:
