authority under s. 163.410 by a county that has adopted a home rule charter, the amount of tax increment to be contributed by any taxing authority shall be limited as follows:

If a taxing authority imposes a millage rate that 20 a. exceeds the millage rate imposed by the governing body that 21 22 created the trust fund, the amount of tax increment to be 23 contributed by the taxing authority imposing the higher millage 24 rate shall be calculated using the millage rate imposed by the 25 governing body that created the trust fund. Nothing shall 26 prohibit any taxing authority from voluntarily contributing a tax increment at a higher rate for a period of time as specified 27 by interlocal agreement between the taxing authority and the 28 29 community redevelopment agency.

b. At any time more than 24 years after the fiscal year in 30 which a taxing authority made its first contribution to a 31 redevelopment trust fund, by resolution effective no sooner than 32 the next fiscal year and adopted by majority vote of the taxing 33 34 authority's governing body at a public hearing held not less 35 than 30 or more than 45 days after written notice by registered 36 mail to the community redevelopment agency and published in a newspaper of general circulation in the redevelopment area, the 37 taxing authority may limit the amount of increment contributed 38 39 by the taxing authority to the redevelopment trust fund to the amount of increment the taxing authority was obligated to 40 41 contribute to the redevelopment trust fund in the fiscal year 276939 - h7013-line58.docx
