#### DCF RFA 2223 035: Mentorship Programs for At-Risk Male Students (MPARMS)

Grant Objectives: The services awarded under the Mentorship Programs for At-Risk Male Students (MPARMS) state grant must assist at-risk male students who are in middle school or high school in developing economic, social, emotional, and cognitive skills to prepare them for future success.

Background: Pursuant to s. 409.1467, F.S., the Department advertised the request for application to disburse grants to community-based not-for-profit organizations incorporated under Chapter 617, F.S., to create new or expand existing mentorship programs for at-risk male students. The applicants could propose a maximum annual fund amount of \$250,000. The Department received 53 applications; 43 applicants were determined to be responsive. The evaluators reviewed and scored the responsive applications. The following applicants were awarded a three-year contract:

# DCF RFA 2223 036: Comprehensive Needs of Fathers (CNF) and Responsible Fatherhood Education Programs (RFEP)

Grant Objectives: The services awarded include but are not limited to assisting fathers in finding employment, managing child support obligations, transitioning from a period of incarceration, accessing health care, understanding child development, enhancing parenting skills; and providing evidence-based education programs specifically for Fathers.

Background: The Department posted two new grant opportunities for eligible applicants. The first opportunity called the Comprehensive Needs of Fathers (CNF) state grant is to provide services to comprehensively address the needs of Fathers. The second grant opportunity called Responsible Fatherhood Education Program (RFEP) is to provide evidencebased education programs for fathers. These grants will be a three-year Grant Award, pursuant to the authority under s. 409.1465, F.S.

- The Department received 48 applications for the CNF state grant and 41 applications for the RFEP state grant.
- 35 applicants for CNF state grant and 27 applicants for RFEP state grant were determined to be responsive.
