## House Offer #2 – April 28, 2011 8:30 pm

- 1. Create Department of Economic Opportunity
  - Agency head appointed by the Governor, confirmed by the Senate
  - Transfer OTTED, portions of DCA, and AWI/Workforce functions to new agency, effective October 1, 2011
  - Transfer Office of Early Learning to DOE as a separate, independent entity, effective July 1, 2011
    - Director of the Office appointed by the Governor, confirmed by the Senate
    - DOE may not impose requirements or standards on Early Learning programs beyond what is authorized currently in law for VPK
    - Auditor General review of programs and delivery systems (including Early Learning Coalitions)
- 2. Consolidate public-private partnerships
  - EFI President is appointed by and serves at the pleasure of the Governor
  - Space FL retains special district status under the EFI board
  - Visit FL direct support organization is retained under contract with the EFI board
  - BBIB and Sports Foundation are merged into EFI
  - EFI board remains as is under current law
  - Matching requirements for EFI and Visit FL remain as required under current law
- 3. Replace Senate growth management language with HB 7129 (as passed by the House)
- 4. Create the SEED Trust Fund
  - Effective July 1, 2012, redirect rental car surcharge TF revenues; \$100 million from STTF; and \$100 million from Housing Trust Funds
- 5. Budget Issues:
  - Fund Deepwater Horizon economic development at \$10 million annually for the next three fiscal years (portions of HB 1309/SB 248)
  - Fund Research & Development at \$7.1 million recurring
  - Do not appropriate FHFC cash
