Provides that the Department of Corrections and the Department of Juvenile Justice may expend appropriated funds to assist in defraying the costs of impacts that are incurred by a municipality or county and associated with opening or operating a facility under the authority of the respective department which is located within that municipality or county. The amount that is to be paid under this section for any facility may not exceed 1 percent of the facility construction cost, less building impact fees imposed by the municipality or by the county if the facility is located in the unincorporated portion of the county. 2	9	6	DOC / CJIC EST. / NEW POSITIONS & \$. Amends s. 216.262, F.S. to allow the Executive Office of the Governor (EOG) to request additional positions and appropriations from unallocated general revenue during the 2011-2012 fiscal year for the Department of Corrections (DOC) if the actual inmate population of the Department of Corrections exceeds the inmate population projections of the February 2011 Criminal Justice Estimating Conference by 1 percent for 2 consecutive months or 2 percent for any month. The additional positions and appropriations may be used for essential staff, fixed capital improvements, and other resources to provide classification, security, food services, health services, and other variable expenses within the institutions to accommodate the estimated increase in the inmate population, and must be approved by the Legislative Budget Commission. 3	10		DOC / CLOSING OF INSTITUTIONS. Provides that DOC must receive prior approval from the OPB and LBC before closing, substantially reducing the use of, or changing the purpose of any state correctional institution.	House	House
