1	23		DOT/ADOPTED WORKPLAN. Amends s. 339.135(4)(a)(3), F.S. to provide Legislative intent to minimize the impacts of reduced revenues. Senate Proposal offers modified language that notwithstands 339.135 (4)(a)(3) and 339.08(4) to provide department maximum flexibility in implementing State Transportation Trust Fund Cash Sweep. 2	24		DOT/OTTED ROAD FUND/WORK PROGRAM/AIRPORT PROJECTS. Amends s. 339.135(5), F.S. Provides that the Department of Transportation shall transfer funds to the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development in an amount equal to \$15,300,000 for the purpose of funding economic development transportation projects. Provides that the transfer shall not reduce, delete, or defer any existing projects funded, as of July 1, 2011, in the Department of Transportation's 5-year work program. Requires Department of Transportation to fund airport development projects specified in the General Appropriations Act, unless requested by the airport sponsor. Provides that in determining the average weekly wage, all remuneration received from the employer shall be considered a gratuity, and the participant shall not be entitled to any benefits otherwise payable under s. 440.15, regardless of whether the participant may be receiving wages and remuneration from other employment with another employer and regardless of his or her future wage-earning capacity.
