The House bill does not specify the use of these fees, maintaining existing statutory language on the matter.</p> <p>The Senate bill also specifies certain fees will be retained by tax collectors who provide driver's license issuance beginning July 1, 2015 or upon the completion of transitioning this service to tax collectors. HB 5501 provides the revenue-sharing requirement is effective July 1, 2011.</p> <p>1. Eliminates language specifying use of fees maintaining existing law. 2. Retains July 1, 2015 date for revenue sharing, or upon completion of transition. 3. Clarifies that tax collectors retain certain fees only when the service is provided by the tax collector. (see attached)</p>

30			<p>Creates a Law Enforcement Consolidation Task Force to evaluate the duplication of law enforcement functions throughout state government and study limiting the jurisdiction of the Florida Highway Patrol to the State Highway System or Florida Intrastate Highway System. The Task Force is required to submit recommendations and a plan for consolidation of law enforcement functions to the Legislature by February 2012.</p> <p>Clarifies that recommendations a plan for consolidation will be submitted if Task Force concludes that state law enforcement consolidation is appropriate. (see attached)</p>		
31			Provides for the transfer of the Office of Motor Carrier Compliance at FDOT to the Florida Highway Patrol at DHSMV and specifies that the Executive Office of the Governor may transfer funds and positions between agencies as approved by the Legislative Budget Commission.
