2011-2012 General Appropriations Act**

This report reflects only items contained in the Conference Report on Senate Bill 2000, the 2011-2012 General Appropriations Act, that are identifiable to specific counties. State agencies will further allocate other funds contained in the General Appropriations Act based on their own authorized distribution methodologies. This report includes all construction, right of way, or public transportation phases \$1 million or greater that are included in the Tentative Work Program for Fiscal Year 2011-2012. The FEFP and funds distributed to counties by state agencies are not identified in this report.

Pages 2 through 27 reflect items that are identifiable to one specific county. Multiple county programs can be found on page 28. This report was produced prior to the veto process; the items contained herein are authorized by the Legislature, but still not officially approved by the Governor.
