9 Any of the following persons, in order of priority (2) listed, may consent to the medical care or treatment of a minor 10 11 who is not committed to the Department of Children and Families 12 or the Department of Juvenile Justice or in their custody under chapter 39, chapter 984, or chapter 985 when, after a reasonable 13 14 attempt, a person who has the power to consent as otherwise 15 provided by law cannot be contacted by the treatment provider 16 and actual notice to the contrary has not been given to the 17 provider by that person:

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18 A health care surrogate designated under s. 765.2035 (a) 19 after September 30, 2015, or a person who possesses a power of 20 attorney to provide medical consent for the minor.
