"A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT RELATING TO DIXIE COUNTY; PROVIDING AN EXCEPTION TO GENERAL LAW, PROVIDING SPACE, SEATING, AND MINIMUM GROSS REVENUE REQUIREMENTS FOR SPECIAL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSES FOR RESTAURANTS IN THE DESCRIBED AREAS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

10 Section 1. Notwithstanding s. 561.20(1), Florida Statutes,
11 the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of the
12 Department of Business and Professional Regulation shall issue a
13 special alcoholic beverage license to a bona fide restaurant
14 located within the jurisdictional boundaries of Town of
15 Horseshoe Beach that is licensed by the Division of Hotels and
16 Restaurants, occupies at least 1,700 square feet of contiguous
17 space used as a part of the food service establishment, is
18 equipped to serve meals to 50 persons at one time, and derives
19 at least 51 percent of its gross food and beverage revenue from
20 the sale of food and nonalcoholic beverages during the first 60-
21 day operating period and each 12-month operating period
22 thereafter. Failure of any licensee issued this special license
23 to meet the required percentage of food and nonalcoholic
24 beverage gross revenues during the covered operating period
25 shall result in the revocation of the license or denial of the

26 pending application for a permanent license of a licensee
27 operating with a temporary license. A licensee whose license is
28 revoked, or an applicant whose pending application for a
29 permanent license is denied, or any person required to qualify
30 on the special food service alcohol license application, is
31 ineligible to have any interest in a subsequent application for
32 such license for a period of 120 days after the date of the
33 final denial or revocation.

34 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
