 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 8 Section 1. Paragraph (k) is added to subsection (2) of
 9 section 934.03, Florida Statutes, to read:

10 934.03 Interception and disclosure of wire, oral, or
 11 electronic communications prohibited.—

13 (k) It is lawful under ss. 934.03-934.09 for a person to
 14 intercept and record an oral communication if the person is a
 15 party to the communication and has reasonable grounds to believe
 16 that the recording will capture a statement by another party to
 17 the communication that the other party intends to commit, is
 18 committing, or has committed an unlawful act of physical force
 19 or violence against a person.

20 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
