7 Section 9. Section 319.141, Florida Statutes is created to
 8 read:

9 319.141 Pilot program for private sector rebuilt vehicle
 10 inspections.

11 (1) Effective October 1, 2013, the department is required
 12 to conduct a pilot program to evaluate alternatives for rebuilt
 13 inspection services to be offered by the private sector. The
 14 purpose of the pilot program is for the department to
 15 investigate the feasibility of private rebuilt vehicle
 16 inspection facilities, the cost impact to the consumer and the
 17 potential savings to the department. The pilot program shall be
 18 limited to Miami-Dade and Hillsborough Counties, and will allow
 19 participating private parties to conduct rebuilt examinations.

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20 (2) For the purpose of this pilot program, "Rebuilt
21 Examination Facility" shall mean a privately owned and operated
22 entity authorized by the department to processes rebuilt
23 vehicles for the department and "Rebuilt Examination" shall mean
24 an examination of a rebuilt vehicle and it's properly endorsed
25 certificate of title, salvage certificate of title or
26 manufacturer's statement of origin submitted to the department,
27 together with an application for a rebuilt certificate of title,
28 a rebuilder's affidavit, a photo of the junk or salvage vehicle
29 taken before any repairs began, receipts or invoices for all
30 Major Component Parts, as defined in s. 319.30(1), that were
31 changed, and proof of reporting of the rebuilding of the vehicle
32 to the National Motor Vehicle Title Information System.

33 (3) The department will establish a memorandum of
34 understanding with each participant in the pilot covering
35 oversight requirements, bonding and insurance requirements,
36 establishing procedures and forms and requiring the electronic
37 transmission of rebuilt documents.

38 Before any person or company can be approved by the department
39 as a Rebuilt Examination Facility, the department shall ensure
40 that the entity meets basic criteria designed to protect the
41 public which shall include the following minimum criteria in
42 addition to other such criteria that the department finds will
43 be necessary to conduct proper inspections:

44 (a) Have and maintain a surety bond or irrevocable letter
45 of credit, executed by the Rebuilt Examination Facility
46 applicant, in the sum of \$50.000.

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47 (b) Have and maintain garage liability insurance for the
48 Rebuilt Examination Facility location.

49 (c) Have completed criminal background checks of all
50 owners, partners, corporate officers and Rebuilt Examination
51 Facility inspectors employed by their company.

52 (4) Pilot program participants are required to access
53 vehicle and titling information and input inspection results
54 through an authorized electronic filing system.

55 (5) The department shall provide a report to the President
56 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representative
57 regarding results of the pilot program by February 1, 2015,
58 unless otherwise extended by an act of the Legislature this
59 section shall expire July 1, 2015.
