11 1. Pay the civil penalty and delinquent fee, if  
12 applicable, either by mail or in person; or

13 2. Enter into a payment plan in accordance with s. 28.246  
14 with the clerk of the court to pay the civil penalty and  
15 delinquent fee, if applicable.

16 3. By February 1, 2014, the Department shall submit a  
17 report to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the  
18 House of Representatives on the feasibility of driver-initiated  
19 payment of civil penalties to law enforcement, transacted

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electronically at the road-side immediately following issuance
