316.126 Operation of vehicles and actions of pedestrians on approach of authorized emergency vehicle <u>and roadside</u> entities.—

- (1) (b) 1. When approaching an entity who is performing a task as described in subparagraph 2. an authorized emergency vehicle making use of any visual signals is parked or a wrecker displaying amber rotating or flashing lights is performing a recovery or loading on the roadside, the driver shall of every other vehicle, as soon as it is safe:
- <u>a.1. Shall</u> Vacate the lane closest to the <u>entity</u> <u>performing the task emergency vehicle or wrecker</u> when driving on an interstate highway or other highway with two or more lanes traveling in the direction of <u>such entity the emergency vehicle</u> <u>or wrecker</u>, <u>unless</u> except when otherwise directed by a law enforcement officer; <u>or</u>. If <u>such movement cannot be safely accomplished</u>, the driver shall reduce speed as provided in <u>subparagraph 2</u>.
- <u>b.2.</u> If such movement described in sub-subparagraph a.

 cannot be safely accomplished, shall slow to a speed that is 20 miles per hour less than the posted speed limit when the posted speed limit is 25 miles per hour or greater; or travel at 5 miles per hour when the posted speed limit is 20 miles per hour or less, when driving on a two-lane road, except when otherwise directed by a law enforcement officer.
