6 (94) SURVEYING AND MAPPING CREW.—One or more surveyors and  
 7 mappers as defined in s. 472.005(3), or employees as defined in  
 8 s. 472.005(9), or subordinates as defined in s. 472.005(10), on  
 9 the roadside who are performing the practice of surveying and  
 10 mapping as defined in s. 472.005(4) (a), and who are accompanied  
 11 by a vehicle that bears an emblem that is visible from the  
 12 roadway or signage that is visible from the roadway.

14 Remove lines 325-374 and insert:

15 Section 4. Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) and subsections  
 16 (2) through (6) of section 316.126, Florida Statutes, are  
 17 amended to read:

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18 316.126 Operation of vehicles and actions of pedestrians  
19 on approach of authorized emergency vehicle and roadside  
20 entities.—

21 (1)(b)1. When approaching an entity who is performing a  
22 task as described in subparagraph 2. ~~an authorized emergency~~  
23 ~~vehicle making use of any visual signals is parked or a wrecker~~  
24 ~~displaying amber rotating or flashing lights is performing a~~  
25 ~~recovery or loading on the roadside,~~ the driver shall ~~of every~~  
26 ~~other vehicle,~~ as soon as it is safe:

27 a.1. ~~Shall~~ Vacate the lane closest to the entity  
28 performing the task ~~emergency vehicle or wrecker~~ when driving on  
29 an interstate highway or other highway with two or more lanes  
30 traveling in the direction of such entity ~~the emergency vehicle~~  
31 ~~or wrecker,~~ unless except when otherwise directed by a law  
32 enforcement officer; ~~or. If such movement cannot be safely~~  
33 ~~accomplished, the driver shall reduce speed as provided in~~  
34 ~~subparagraph 2.~~

35 b.2. If such movement described in sub-subparagraph a.  
36 cannot be safely accomplished, ~~shall~~ slow to a speed that is 20  
37 miles per hour less than the posted speed limit when the posted  
38 speed limit is 25 miles per hour or greater; or travel at 5  
39 miles per hour when the posted speed limit is 20 miles per hour  
40 or less, when driving on a two-lane road, except when otherwise  
41 directed by a law enforcement officer.

42 2. Subparagraph 1. applies to every driver approaching:

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43 a. An authorized emergency vehicle that is parked on the  
44 roadside and displaying any visual signals;

45 b. A sanitation vehicle that is performing a task related  
46 to the provision of sanitation services on the roadside;

47 c. A utility service vehicle that is performing a task  
48 related to utility services on the roadside;

49 d. A wrecker that is displaying amber rotating or flashing  
50 lights and performing a recovery or loading on the roadside;

51 e. A surveying and mapping crew that is performing a task  
52 on the roadside related to the practice of surveying and mapping  
53 pursuant to s. 472.005(4)(a).
