 7 September 5, 1997, the dosage of Pitocin was consistently
 8 increased and Mitzi Roden began to experience contractions
 9 closer than every 2 minutes at 4:50 p.m., and began to
 10 experience excessive uterine contractility shortly before 6
 11 p.m., which should have been recognized by any reasonably
 12 competent obstetric care provider, and

13 WHEREAS, in spite of Mitzi Roden's excessive uterine
 14 contractility, the administration of Pitocin was inappropriately
 15 increased to 13 milliunits at 6:20 p.m. by Labor and Delivery
 16 Nurse Beth Jencks, which was a deviation from the acceptable
