A bill to be entitled

An act relating to voting systems; amending s. 101.5606, F.S.; providing an additional requirement for Department of State approval of certain voting systems; requiring production of a paper record meeting specified criteria; requiring preservation of and access to such a record; providing for use of such record in a recount of certain elections; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (16) is added to section 101.5606, Florida Statutes, to read:

101.5606 Requirements for approval of systems.--No electronic or electromechanical voting system shall be approved by the Department of State unless it is so constructed that:

(16) It produces a voter-verifiable paper record that is suitable for a manual audit and is equivalent or superior to the paper record of a paper ballot box system such that the voting system, at minimum:

(a) Produces a permanent paper record, each individual paper record of which is made available for inspection and verification by the voter at the time the vote is cast and preserved within the polling place in the manner in which all other paper ballots are preserved within the polling place on election day for later use in any manual audit.

(b) Provides the voter with an opportunity to correct any error made by the system before the permanent record is

preserved for use in any manual audit. The voter-verified pape
record produced under this subsection shall be available as an
official record pursuant to chapter 119 and shall be the
official record used for any recount conducted with respect to
any election in which the system is used.
