that the one credit in physical education be taken during the 26 27 9th grade year. Completion of one semester with a grade of "C" 28 or better in a marching band class, in a physical activity class 29 that requires participation in marching band activities as an 30 extracurricular activity, or in a dance class shall satisfy one-31 half credit in physical education or one-half credit in 32 performing arts. This credit may not be used to satisfy the 33 personal fitness requirement or the requirement for adaptive physical education under an individual education plan (IEP) or 34 35 504 plan. Completion of 2 years in a Reserve Officer Training Corps (R.O.T.C.) class, a significant component of which is 36 37 drills, shall satisfy the one-credit requirement in physical education and the one-credit requirement in performing arts. 38 39 This credit may not be used to satisfy the personal fitness requirement or the requirement for adaptive physical education 40 under an IEP or 504 plan. 41
