Section 1. Section 1009.215, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

1009.215 Nonresident tuition exemption.

- (1) Beginning with the 2011 fall term, a student, other than a nonimmigrant alien within the meaning of 8 U.S.C. s. 1101(a)(15), is exempt from paying nonresident tuition at a state university or a Florida College System institution if the student meets all of the following requirements:
- (a) Attended high school in the state for 3 or more years, which need not be consecutive.
- (b) Graduated from a high school in the state or attained a high school equivalency diploma pursuant to s. 1003.435.
- (c) Registered as an entering student or is currently enrolled at a state university or a Florida College System institution.
- (d) In the case of a student without lawful immigration status, files an affidavit with the state university or the

Florida College System institution stating that the student has
filed an application to legalize his or her immigration status
or will file an application as soon as he or she is eligible to
do so.
(2) The Board of Governors shall adopt regulations and the
State Board of Education shall adopt rules to implement the

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
