A bill to be entitled

An act relating to state-approved teacher preparation programs; amending s. 1004.04, F.S.; specifying that the State Board of Education adopt rules that require certain students in state-approved teacher preparation programs to assist teachers with low-performing students in reading as part of certain field experiences; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 1004.04, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1004.04 Public accountability and state approval for teacher preparation programs.—

- (2) UNIFORM CORE CURRICULA.-
- (a) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules pursuant to ss. 120.536(1) and 120.54 that establish uniform core curricula for each state-approved teacher preparation program.
- (b) The rules to establish uniform core curricula for each state-approved teacher preparation program must include, but are not limited to, a State Board of Education identified foundation in scientifically researched, knowledge-based reading literacy and computational skills acquisition; classroom management; school safety; professional ethics; educational law; human development and learning; and understanding of the Sunshine State Standards content measured by state achievement tests, reading and interpretation of data, and use of data to improve student achievement.

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(c) These rules must include the requirement that a student in a state-approved teacher preparation program, as part of a preservice field experience course, internship, or student teaching assignment at the elementary school level, assist teachers who are teaching low-performing students in reading in a public elementary school in the school district in which the program is located.

(d) (c) These rules shall not require an additional period of time-to-degree but may be phased in to enable teacher preparation programs to supplant courses, including pedagogy courses, not required by law or State Board of Education rule with the courses and assignments identified pursuant to paragraphs paragraph (b) and (c).

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
