12 career attorneys for the repayment of eligible student loans.

14 (a) "Administering body" means the Justice Administrative
15 Commission when the eligible career attorney is employed as an
16 assistant state attorney or assistant public defender or the
17 Office of the Attorney General when the eligible career attorney
18 is employed as an assistant attorney general or assistant

25 (c) "Eligible student loan" means a loan that was issued
26 pursuant to the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, to an
27 eligible career attorney to fund his or her law school
28 education, and that is not in default.

29 (d) "Maximum available amount" means, in the event an
30 appropriation is less than the amount necessary to fund total
31 payments by the administering body under paragraph (3)(b), the
32 amount that results from multiplication of the percentage of
33 total funding appropriated by the payment amount of \$3,000 or
34 \$5,000, as appropriate under paragraph (3)(b). The percentage of
35 total funding appropriated is the amount that results from
36 division of the amount of the appropriation by the amount
37 necessary to fund total payments under paragraph (3)(b).

38 (3) The student loan assistance program shall be
39 administered in the following manner:

40 (a) Within 30 days after an individual's employment
41 anniversary date, the individual may submit to his or her
42 employer a certification affidavit on a form authorized by the
43 administering body, which certifies that he or she, as of his or
44 her last employment anniversary date, is an eligible career
45 attorney with one or more eligible student loans. Upon approval
46 by the employing state attorney, public defender, Attorney
47 General, or Statewide Prosecutor, the certification affidavit
48 shall be submitted to the administering body within 60 days
49 following the eligible career attorney's last employment
50 anniversary date.

63 or her eligible student loan obligation.

64 2. To the lender that services the eligible student loan
65 between July 1st and July 31st of the next fiscal year following
66 receipt of the certification affidavit by the administering
67 body.

68 3. For the eligible student loan with the highest current
69 interest rate, if the eligible career attorney has more than one
70 eligible student loan.

71 (d) Payments under paragraph (b) shall cease upon totaling
72 \$44,000 per eligible career attorney or upon full satisfaction of
73 the eligible student loan, whichever occurs first.

74 (4) The student loan assistance program shall be funded
75 annually by an appropriation from the General Revenue Fund to
76 the administering body.

77 (5) The administering body shall adopt rules to implement
78 this section.

Creation of the State Law Enforcement Node



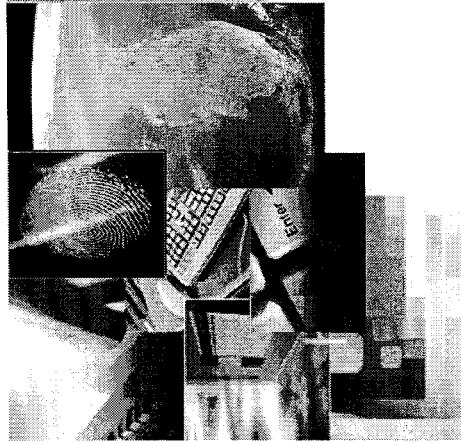

- Revised Statewide Information and Intelligence Sharing Strategy

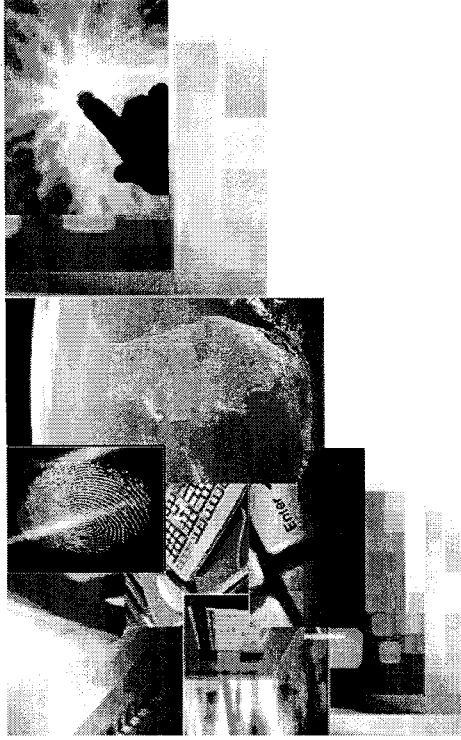


Accomplishments February 2005 to Present

- Progress Report supported and validated by Domestic Security Oversight Council on 10-12-05
- Developed Statement Of Work associated with Phase 1 “Data Mapping” efforts
- Began requirement documents for Phase 2 - physical infrastructure to share data
- Integrated an FDLE Internal Auditor to review project procurements and expenditures

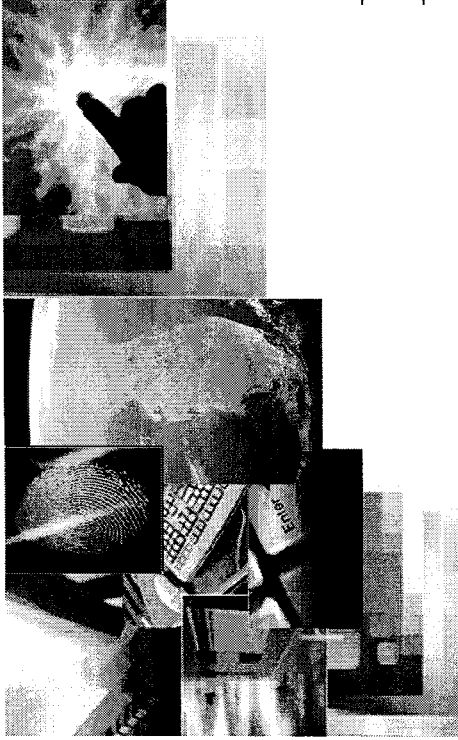
Future – Next Steps

- Development and signing of formal MOUs, between respective entities/project participants
- Development of Privacy Policies in conjunction with individual project and statewide applications
- Complete sub-grant applications for each project to receive DHS/OPD funds for individual projects
- Finalize the creation of the initial Florida Law Enforcement Connectivity Data Dictionary which will refine the data elements that will be shared



Future – Next Steps

- Ensure that all Regions are conducting “data mapping” of individual agency data to the Global Justice XML Data Model (GJXDM) standard for data sharing
- Develop the requirement documents in conjunction with Phase 3 - to provide the high end analytic capability “web utility belt” for system users
- Identify additional funding needs for consideration at the upcoming Domestic Security Funding Conference
- Identify sustainment requirements with respect to system support and maintenance
