10 (1) No later than 10 days after receiving the court's
 11 findings regarding the amount of compensation, the Chief
 12 Financial Officer shall request release of funds pursuant to
 13 chapter 216, Florida Statutes if funds have been appropriated in
 14 a qualified expenditure category in the General Appropriations
 15 Act for the purposes specified in this act. In addition, if any
 16 such appropriation is insufficient to satisfy the claim, the
 17 Chief Financial Officer shall request the balance in the
 18 agency's next legislative budget request or amended legislative
 19 budget request submission. If there is no appropriation for this
 20 purpose the entirety of the claim shall be requested in the
 21 agency's next legislative budget request or amended legislative
 22 budget request submission.

HOUSE AMENDMENT FOR COUNCIL/COMMITTEE PURPOSES

Amendment No. (01)

23 (2) Subject to specific appropriation and upon release of
24 the requested funds by the Legislative Budget Commission, the
25 Department of Financial Services shall pay the amount of
26 compensation as determined by the court pursuant to section 3 of
27 this act. The Department of Financial Services is directed to
28 execute all necessary agreements to implement this act including
29 purchase of an annuity or make such other payment as determined
30 by the court. Payment shall not be made until delivery by the
31 claimant to the Chief Financial Officer of an executed release
32 and waiver on behalf of the claimant and his or her parents,
33 heirs, successors, and assigns forever releasing the State of
34 Florida and any agency, instrumentality, officer, employee, or
35 political subdivision thereof, or any other entity subject to
36 the provisions of s. 768.28, Florida Statutes, from any and all
37 present or future claims or declaratory relief the claimant or
38 any of his or her parents, heirs, successors, or assigns may
39 have against such enumerated entities and arising out of the
40 factual situation in connection with the conviction for which
41 compensation is awarded. However, declaratory action to obtain
42 judicial expunction of the claimant's judicial and executive
43 branch records as otherwise provided by law is not prohibited by
44 this act.

45 (3) After receiving a certified finding from the court
46 that a claimant is eligible for compensation, including a
47 finding regarding the amount of compensation and a finding
48 regarding attorney's fees and costs, and after release of funds
49 pursuant to this section, the Department of Financial Services
50 shall issue separate warrants to the named attorneys for the
