Re: Consent Procedure for Trust Fund Bills on Special Order, April 2, 2008

Dear Mr. Speaker:

Pursuant to Rule 10.13, the Rules & Calendar Council hereby submits the following Consent Calendar procedure to govern Trust Fund Bills placed on the April 2, 2008, Special Order Calendar. Because the bills will be read twice on the same day and voted en bloc, adoption of this procedure requires a two-thirds vote.

House Trust Fund Bills listed in the Trust Fund section of the Special Order Calendar shall be paired with their Senate Companions that are then on the House Calendar.

- Any member may object to a bill on the Trust Fund Section of the Special Order by filing a written objection with the Rules & Calendar Council by 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, April 1, 2008.
- Bills to which objections have been filed or to which amendments are offered will be considered separately at the end of the Special Order Calendar.
- Following substitution of any Senate companion for the House Trust Fund Bill, the Senate Trust Fund Bill (or the House Trust Fund Bill if there is no Senate companion on the calendar) will be read twice by title, followed by a brief explanation by a sponsoring member. The roll call vote will be conducted after the conclusion of the readings of all bills to be considered en bloc.
- Adoption of this procedure will constitute consent on the part of the House to:
 - The substitution of Senate companions and their consideration in lieu of the House bills,
 - A blanket motion to waive the Rules and read each bill a second and third time by title on the same day,
 - The taking of one vote on all bills on the Trust Fund Calendar after all have been read a second and third time by title.

- Any member may vote “no” on any particular Trust Fund Bill by submitting a Trust Fund Vote Form to the Clerk. The Clerk will have the forms available at the desk.

A quorum was present in person, and a majority of those present agreed to the above Report.
