29 Section 1. Section 14.325, Florida Statutes, is repealed.
 30 Reviser's note.--The cited section, which creates the
 31 Council on State Agency Inspectors General, was repealed
 32 pursuant to its own terms, effective June 30, 2007.

33 Section 2. Subsections (4), (5), (6), (7), and (8) of
 34 section 211.027, Florida Statutes, are repealed.

35 Reviser's note.--Subsections (4), (5), and (6), which
 36 relate to tax exemptions for oil and gas produced under
 37 specified parameters, were repealed pursuant to subsection
 38 (8), effective June 30, 2007. Subsection (7) only serves to
 39 prohibit new exemptions per subsections (4)-(6) after June
 40 30, 2002, and has served its purpose; subsection (8) only
 41 serves to provide the repeal of subsections (4)-(6) and has
 42 served its purpose.

43 Section 3. Paragraph (i) of subsection (2) of section
 44 216.181, Florida Statutes, is repealed.

45 Reviser's note.--The cited paragraph, which authorizes the
 46 Agency for Persons with Disabilities to submit a specified
 47 budget amendment, expired pursuant to its own terms,
 48 effective July 1, 2007.

49 Section 4. Subsection (4) of section 252.373, Florida
 50 Statutes, is repealed.

51 Reviser's note.--The cited subsection, which provides that
 52 otherwise unobligated funds in the Emergency Management,
 53 Preparedness, and Assistance Trust Fund may be authorized
 54 for expenditures to provide assistance to local governments
 55 for implementing local comprehensive plans, innovative
 56 planning to make communities more livable, and addressing

57 growth management issues, expired pursuant to its own
 58 terms, effective July 1, 2007.

59 Section 5. Paragraph (b) of subsection (4) and paragraph
 60 (g) of subsection (11) of section 259.032, Florida Statutes, are
 61 repealed.

62 Reviser's note.--Paragraph (4)(b), which relates to
 63 transfer of moneys from the Conservation and Recreation
 64 Lands Trust Fund to the Florida Forever Trust Fund or the
 65 Land Acquisition Trust Fund, expired pursuant to its own
 66 terms, effective July 1, 2007. Paragraph (11)(g), which
 67 provides for a specified appropriation from funds deposited
 68 into the Florida Preservation 2000 Trust Fund and the
 69 Florida Forever Trust Fund for construction of replacement
 70 museum facilities for the 2006-2007 fiscal year, expired
 71 pursuant to its own terms, effective July 1, 2007.

72 Section 6. Paragraph (b) of subsection (14) of section
 73 287.057, Florida Statutes, is repealed.

74 Reviser's note.--The cited paragraph, which authorizes the
 75 implementation of a privatization initiative for a secure
 76 facility by the Department of Children and Family Services,
 77 expired pursuant to its own terms, effective July 1, 2007.

78 Section 7. Section 288.039, Florida Statutes, is repealed.

79 Reviser's note.--The cited section, which relates to the
 80 Employing and Training our Youths (ENTRY) program, expired
 81 pursuant to its own terms, effective June 30, 2007.

82 Section 8. Subsection (3) of section 311.22, Florida
 83 Statutes, is repealed.

84 Reviser's note.--The cited subsection, which relates to a
 85 minimum 25 percent match of funds received for certain
 86 dredging projects for the 2006-2007 fiscal year only,
 87 expired pursuant to its own terms, effective July 1, 2007.

88 Section 9. Subsection (4) of section 370.13, Florida
 89 Statutes, is repealed.

90 Reviser's note.--The cited subsection, which provides for
 91 waiver of stone crab trap tag fees for the 2006-2007 fiscal
 92 year only, expired pursuant to its own terms, effective
 93 July 1, 2007.

94 Section 10. Subsection (7) of section 370.142, Florida
 95 Statutes, is repealed.

96 Reviser's note.--The cited subsection, which provides for
 97 waiver of spiny lobster trap tag fees for the 2006-2007
 98 fiscal year only, expired pursuant to its own terms,
 99 effective July 1, 2007.

100 Section 11. Subsection (12) of section 373.59, Florida
 101 Statutes, is repealed.

102 Reviser's note.--The cited subsection, which authorizes
 103 transfer of moneys from the Water Management Lands Trust
 104 Fund to the Florida Forever Trust Fund or the Land
 105 Acquisition Trust Fund, expired pursuant to its own terms,
 106 effective July 1, 2007.

107 Section 12. Paragraph (b) of subsection (3) of section
 108 375.041, Florida Statutes, is repealed.

109 Reviser's note.--The cited paragraph, which authorizes
 110 expenditure or transfer to the Florida Forever Trust Fund
 111 and the Save Our Everglades Trust Fund of moneys in the

118 Reviser's note.--The cited subsection, which provides that
 119 the Department of Health may not use any portion of the
 120 annual appropriation for the area health education center
 121 network to administer or evaluate the network, expired
 122 pursuant to its own terms, effective July 1, 2007.

123 Section 14. Subsection (3) of section 403.885, Florida
 124 Statutes, is repealed.

125 Reviser's note.--The cited subsection, which provides for a
 126 grant program to use funds appropriated for certain water
 127 projects, expired pursuant to its own terms, effective July
 128 1, 2007.

129 Section 15. Subsection (2) of section 502.015, Florida
 130 Statutes, is repealed.

131 Reviser's note.--The cited subsection, which provides that,
 132 for the 2006-2007 fiscal year only, moneys in the General
 133 Inspection Trust Fund may be appropriated for programs
 134 operated by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer
 135 Services which are related to the programs authorized under
 136 chapter 502, which relates to milk and milk products,
 137 expired pursuant to its own terms, effective July 1, 2007.

171 (2) In the event that the eligibility to serve as a member
 172 of the board of directors of a condominium association,
 173 cooperative association, homeowners' association, or mobile home
 174 owners' association is restricted to membership in such
 175 association and membership is appurtenant to ownership of a
 176 unit, parcel, or mobile home, a grantor of a trust described in
 177 s. 733.707(3), or a beneficiary as defined in former s.
 178 737.303(4)(b) of a trust which owns a unit, parcel, or mobile
 179 home shall be deemed a member of the association and eligible to
 180 serve as a director of the condominium association, cooperative
 181 association, homeowners' association, or mobile home owners'
 182 association, provided that said beneficiary occupies the unit,
 183 parcel, or mobile home.
