 42 39.817, 383.0115, 393.22, 393.503, 402.3045, 402.50, 409.1673,
 43 409.1685, 409.801, 409.802, and 409.803, Florida Statutes, are
 44 repealed.

45 Section 2. Section 39.3031, Florida Statutes, is amended
