promotion and marketing of the specialty license plate.

- (a) The department shall develop a Florida Horse Park license plate as provided in this section. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Discover Florida's Horses" must appear at the bottom of the plate.
- (b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the Florida Agriculture Center and Horse Park Authority created by s. 570.952, which shall retain all proceeds until all startup costs for developing and establishing the plate have been recovered. Thereafter, the proceeds shall be used as follows:
- 1. A maximum of 5 percent of the proceeds from the annual use fees may be used for the administration of the Florida Horse Park license plate program.
- 2. A maximum of 5 percent of the proceeds may be used to promote and market the license plate.
- 3. The remaining proceeds shall be used by the authority to promote the Florida Agriculture Center and Horse Park located in Marion County; to support continued development of the park, including the construction of additional educational facilities,

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barns, and other structures; to provide improvements to the existing infrastructure at the park; and to provide for operational expenses of the Florida Agriculture Center and Horse Park.

- (72) FLORIDA BIODIVERSITY FOUNDATION LICENSE PLATES .--
- The department shall develop a Florida Biodiversity (a) Foundation license plate as provided in this section. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Save Wild Florida" must appear at the bottom of the plate.
- The annual use fees shall be distributed to the Florida Biodiversity Foundation, Inc., which shall retain 50 percent of the proceeds until the startup costs to develop and establish the plates have been recovered. Thereafter, the proceeds shall be used as follows:
- 1. A maximum of 10 percent of the proceeds may be used to fund the administrative, promotion, and marketing costs of the license plate program and the foundation.
- 2. The remaining fees shall be used by the foundation to fund research, education, and scientific study of the diversity of animals and plants and to aid in the preservation, study, conservation, and recovery of imperiled organisms.

- (1) That portion of U.S. Highway 1, also known as State Road 5, between S.W. 104th Street and S.W. 112th Street in Miami-Dade County is designated as "Lt. Colonel Charles Brown Memorial Highway."
- (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating Lt. Colonel Charles Brown Memorial Highway as described in subsection (1).
- Section 6. Section 17 of chapter 2008-256, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:
- Section 17. <u>Dr.</u> Jose A. Marques Boulevard designated;
 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--
- (1) That portion of 8th Street between S.W. 107th Avenue and S.W. 127th 117th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is designated as "Dr. Jose A. Marques Boulevard."

The Department of Transportation is directed to erect (2) suitable markers designating Dr. Jose A. Marques Boulevard as described in subsection (1).
