 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 8 Section 1. The Legislature finds that s. 985.033 defines
 9 the substantive scope of a child's right to counsel in juvenile
 10 court proceedings and that this section has not been found to be
 11 constitutionally invalid in any case or controversy. The
 12 Legislature finds that Rule 8.165(a), Florida Rules of Juvenile
 13 Procedure, relating to the duty of the court to provide counsel
 14 to parties, is a substantive expansion of the right to legal
 15 counsel beyond what has been authorized by the Legislature.
 16 Rule 8.165(a), Florida Rules of Juvenile Procedure, relating to
 17 the duty of the court to provide counsel to parties, is
 18 repealed.

19 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming law,
 20 provided this act is enacted by two-thirds vote of the
 21 membership of each house of the Legislature.
