 19 a bargaining agent and that represents employees who are law

20 enforcement officers, as defined in s. 943.10(1), or
21 firefighters, as defined in s. 633.30(1), shall have the right
22 to have its dues and uniform assessments deducted and collected
23 by the employer from the salaries of those employees who
24 authorize the deduction of said dues and uniform assessments.
25 However, such authorization is revocable at the employee's
26 request upon 30 days' written notice to the employer and
27 employee organization. Said deductions shall commence upon the
28 bargaining agent's written request to the employer. Reasonable
29 costs to the employer of said deductions shall be a proper
30 subject of collective bargaining. Such right to deduction,
31 unless revoked pursuant to s. 447.507, shall be in force for so
32 long as the employee organization remains the certified
33 bargaining agent for the employees in the unit. The public
34 employer is expressly prohibited from any involvement in the
35 collection of fines, penalties, or special assessments.
